

Before checking-in

A number of measures are taken at the airport to protect your safety. This means on international flights, some items cannot be taken in your carry-on bag/s through Security Screening.

Pack in your checked-in bag/s any:



Liquids if container larger than 100mls.



Gels if container larger than 100mls.



Aerosols if container larger than 100mls.



More than a total 350ml of some powders or granular material

Before checking-in

To make your trip run smoothly, be aware of what you can or cannot take into the cabin. These items must be removed from your carry-on bag/s and placed in your checked-in bag/s.

Do you have any of the following items in your **CARRY-ON** bag/s?







Hand tools longer than 20cm



Sports gear



Knife or scissor blades longer than 6cm



Tool blades with shafts longer than 6cm



Remove loose batteries, powerbanks and cigarette vapes from your checked-in bag/s and place in carry-on.
