

ASTPs and workshops description

Title: Airport Security Programme Workshop (ASP)

Duration: 5 days

Short description:

This 5 day workshop provides for a better understanding of ICAO requirements pertaining to Airport Security Programmes, as well as providing for familiarization of the ICAO Model Airport Security Programme and related guidance found in the ICAO Security Manual Doc 8973 (Res). The workshop assists attendees in correlating regulatory requirements outlined at the national level with written procedures pertaining to an airport's security programme. Utilizing a "fictitious" airport scenario, attendees will draft portions of an ASP in a setting similar to that they would encounter within their States or airports. This is a highly interactive workshop.

Target population:

- Any personnel involved in the development/update of Airport Aviation Security Programmes.
- Management, supervisors and personnel involved in the regulation and implementation of aviation security including the:
 - State's Appropriate Authority for Aviation Security involved in the regulatory activities and implementation oversight of aviation security
 - Airport operators
 - Aviation security services providers
 - Providers of air traffic and air navigation services
 - Other government or industry elements directly involved

Entry requirements:

- written and oral command of the language of instruction;
- experience in a position within organizations mentioned in the target population;
- it is desirable that trainees should have attended a specialized aviation security management course

Workshop objectives:

- Demonstrate an understanding of the ICAO requirements for an Airport Security Programme;
- Become familiar with ICAO's Model Airport Security Programme as well as guidance provided in the ICAO Security Manual (Doc 8973 Restricted);
- Demonstrate the ability to correlate regulatory requirements outlined at the national level with written procedures as they pertain to an airport's security operations; and
- Utilizing a fictitious airport setting, draft "sample" portions of an Airport Security Programme.
