

ASTPs and workshops description

Title: National Civil Aviation Security (AVSEC) Training Programme Course

Duration: 9 days

Short description:

The 9-day course has been developed to provide the appropriate authorities with the knowledge and skills to enable them to develop and implement a National AVSEC Training Programme that addresses training requirements for personnel involved in or responsible for the implementation of various aspects of the State's national civil aviation security programme, to include certification requirements.

Target population:

Candidates at the senior to middle management level within a State's authority charged with the development and/or oversight of the National Civil AVSEC Training Programme and who are also experienced in operational aviation security (AVSEC) matters will be given first priority for this training activity.

Entry requirements:

It is desirable that candidates should have already attended a specialized AVSEC training activity such as the Screener Certification Programme Workshop or the National Civil Aviation Security Quality Control Programme Workshop.

Course objectives:

The course requires students to successfully pass a mastery examination based on ICAO Annex 17, the *Security Manual for Safeguarding Civil Aviation Against Acts of Unlawful Interference* (Doc 8973 Restricted) and materials presented during the course. As this is a "Pass/Fail" course, students must successfully pass the mastery examination in order to receive a certificate of completion. All others shall receive a Certificate of Attendance.
