

ASTPs and workshops description

Title: Screener Certification Process Workshop

Duration: 5 days

Short description:

During this workshop attendees will familiarize themselves with Annex 17, Amendment 11 as it relates to quality control and the general principals screener certification. Students will familiarize themselves with guidance materials incorporated in the ICAO Security Manual Doc 8973 (Res) and the process for conducting Screener Certification as part of the National Civil Aviation Security Quality Control Programme. Although there is no requirement for a Screener Certification *Programme*, attendees will be provided with an opportunity to develop a draft a Screener Certification document , which may then be applied as a stand alone programme or incorporated in to an existing national AVSEC programme. This is a highly interactive workshop.

Target population:

- Management, supervisors and personnel involved in the regulation and implementation of aviation security including the:
 - State's Appropriate Authority for Aviation Security involved in the regulatory activities and implementation oversight of aviation security
 - Airport operators
 - Screening entities
 - Regulated air cargo agents
 - Other government or industry elements directly involved
- Any personnel involved in the development/update of Civil Aviation Security Quality Control Programmes.

Entry requirements:

- personnel who will be part of a dedicated team responsible for the development of a National Quality Control Programme to include the Screener Certification process or requirements;
- have written and oral command of the language of instruction;
- at least five (5) years operational experience in a position within organizations mentioned in the target population;
- it is desirable that trainees should have attended a specialized aviation security quality control course or workshop

Workshop objectives:

- Describe the ICAO requirements and benefits to be derived from having a Screener Certification Programme.
- Demonstrate a working knowledge of the ICAO Model Screener Certification Programme as well as guidance provided in the ICAO Security Manual (Doc 8973 Restricted).
- Correlate regulatory requirements outlined at the national level with written procedures as they pertain to the screener certification and recertification process.
- Be able to draft "sample" portions of a Screener Certification Programme.
