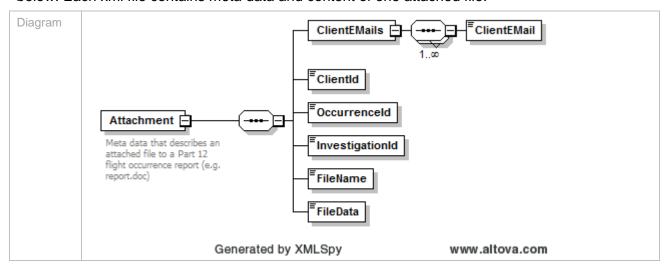

Element Name	Example	Description
xs:normalizedString	Report.doc	String, where newline, tab and carriage-return characters are converted to space characters before schema processing.
xs:token	info@caa.govt.nz	String, where newline, tab and carriage-return characters are converted to space characters before schema processing. Adjacent space characters are collapsed to a single space character, and leading and trailing spaces are removed.
xs:base64Binary	UjBsR09E	Base64-encoded binary data
xs:int	123	32 bit integer value
